**MEETING SUMMARY**

**A. Introductions & Welcome**

Sheila McKinley (CBBEL) welcomed everyone to the meeting. **B. Review of Cost-Share Ranking Sheet**

The committee discussed potential changes to the cost-share ranking sheet to make it more user-friendly and allow for more varied rankings on certain questions. Shaena will keep a running list of suggested changes to be made if/when we decide to revise the cost-share document.

**C. Discussion of Cost-Share Application Rankings and Recommendations for Approval**

The committee ranked and then discussed twelve cost-share applications. Below are the recommendations of the UWRWA Technical Committee to the UWRWA Board of Directors:

- 29<sup>TH</sup> STREET GREENSPACE: Approve for \$4,157.63.
- CHURCH RAIN GARDEN: Approve for \$3,150.
- FORTVILLE RESIDENTIAL RAIN GARDEN: Deny at this time. Request they re-apply later with neighbor/community participation (like Pendleton's bundle of applications).
- FORTVILLE RIPARIAN COVER: Approve for \$10,000.
- GRADE STABILIZATION STRUCTURE: Deny. Lack of habitat, educational opportunities, visibility.
- GEIST DETENTION BASIN AND SHORELINE PLANTINGS: Approve for \$3,937.50.
- MCCORDSVILLE PAVERS, PLANTINGS, & MORE: Approve for \$18,330.
- MORSE HEALTHY SHORES: Approve for \$42,187.50.
- MILLERSVILLE DETENTION BASIN AND TREE PLANTINGS: Approve for \$8,175.
- NO-TILL PROJECT: Deny. Lack of land ownership.
- PENDLETON BUNDLE OF PROJECTS: Approve for \$31,162.50.
- WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP PAVERS & PLANTINGS: Approve for \$30,000.
