LOCAL CLEAN WATER CAMPAIGNS

RIVER ASSESSMENT FIELD TEAMS (RAFT)

The River Assessment Field Teams (RAFTs) are individuals, family members, or small groups of friends, colleagues, or neighbors who are willing to donate time to help strategically assess local water quality.



STORMWATER ACTION TEAMS (SWAT)

A SWAT is a StormWater Action Team. SWATs are groups of kids, colleagues, or neighbors that are willing to donate time to help steward storm drains and promote water quality awareness in neighborhoods or commercial centers.

INDIANA WATER SUMMIT

WHITE RIVER REPORT CARD

The White River Report Card is an assessment and communication tool to measure community progress, align partners and activities, and inspire change that improves our river and its watershed while preserving the community and economy.



TRAINED INDIVIDUAL CONTRACTOR CERTIFICATION

The Trained Individual Contractor Certification Program provides training and testing for those responsible for the management of Rule 5-permitted construction projects in Indiana, also known as a "Trained Individual".



STORMWATER LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE TRAINING

This training provides information to Homeowners Associations, property managers, and landscape contractors about stormwater infrastructure within properties they maintain, how to understand maintenance requirements, and read operation & maintenance plans.
