The Regional Stormwater MS4 Program works by each MS4 pooling funds into a common account, leveraging additional grant dollars, and working together (under the guidance of White Rivers Alliance's expert technical and education staff) in order to deliver a diverse outreach program that meets the needs of targeted audiences. Fees to participate in the program are based upon the population of the MS4 or the combined population of co-permitted MS4s. The program has received high praise and recognition from the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) for the quality of its products and the thoroughness of its reporting. Participating MS4s work as a team to accomplish shared goals and meet and exceed regulatory expectations under Rule 13.
