


What is Source Water and SWP?


- **Source Water-** a raw, untreated supply of water- typically surface water or groundwater- used for current or potential future drinking water.
- **Source Water Protection-** a proactive approach to safeguarding, maintaining, or improving the quality and/or quantity of drinking water sources and their contributing areas.









