

SYSTEM FAILURES



WHAT HAPPENS?

- Sewage backflow
- Sewage in yards
- Neighbor water quality decline
 - Environmental degradation

WHY?

- Soil quality
- Improper design
- Poor system use, management, or maintenance by the homeowner

15,000+ new system permits/year
6,000 repair permits/year



200,000 failing systems

15.3 billion gal raw sewage/year

GRANT PILOT PROGRAM


- Funding through priority system
