

Washington Update

Congress

- Unified Republican Control
 - House: slim majority
 - Senate: secure majority
- FY26 Appropriations House Bill:
 - Increases some Title XVI grants
 - Alternative Water Source Grants funded
 - ⚠ Major cuts to State Revolving Funds

Administration

- Federal agencies: narrower focus on core functions
- Reverse spending and policies related to climate change mitigation and green energy
- First-Term Trump Admin launched Water Reuse Action Plan

March 2024

- Ohio EPA led the charge in forming a state section.
- Focus on member/utility education through meetings & webcasts.
- Case study: New Albany, Ohio planning for water reuse to serve planned Intel microchip fab.



December 2025

- Working to develop water reuse regulations.
- Case-by-case permits for reuse exist.
- Case study: Oswego, KS has been irrigating golf courses with recycled water since 1990's.



March 2025

- Newest section focused on developing rules to allow non-potable reuse.
- Case Study: Illinois Quantum & Microelectronics Park in Chicago planning onsite reuse.
